What is an Employee Assistance Program?

An Employee Assistance Program (EAP) is a free, voluntary and confidential counselling service available to employees.

Whether it's a personal or professional issue, at home or in the workplace, an EAP is there to support you.

What are some of the problems that an EAP can help with?

- Issues affecting work
- Relationship issues
- · Family difficulties
- Personal problems
- Stress and anxiety
- Interpersonal conflicts
- Alcohol or drug related issues
- Grief and loss
- Financial hardship

The EAP can also assist with referral to other support services if required.

Why use an EAP?
