Tenancy Plus program



About Tenancy Plus

The Tenancy Plus program supports individuals and families living in public or community housing where their housing may be at risk. We work with people to maintain safe, appropriate, and sustainable accommodation.

When can support be helpful?

Support and information can be provided in any of the following areas:

- Starting or maintaining a tenancy
- Responding to eviction notices
- Responding to breach notices
- Advocacy at VCAT hearings
- Advice regarding your rights and responsibilities as a renter
- Submitting transfer applications
- Applying for modifications to your property
- Addressing property condition concerns
- Referrals to other specialised services

Eligibility

Support can be provided to renters who may be at risk of breakdowns in their housing or who need support to establish themselves in their new home.

How to access this service

If you live in public housing or community housing, please call us on 03 5226 8900 and ask to speak with someone in our intake team.

We accept referrals into the Tenancy Plus program at all times. Please be aware that there may be a wait of several weeks to access this service during periods of high demand.
